Welcome to the 2017 SAHJA Medal Finals Horse Show! Leone Equestrians is pleased and honored to be hosting the show this year and hope to make your experience, whether riding in the Finals or just coming to show, the best it can be. If you are not riding in the Finals, Friday afternoon and Saturday will have plenty of classes for those with a Leone high point award as your goal, or if all you desire is to get your horse to a show on a beautiful spring weekend. Following are a few things to remember regarding your entries:

- 1.** We request that riders pre-enter the Medal Finals and that any stall reservations are prepaid by mailing them postmarked no later than April 14th. Each Medal finals entry is \$65 and stalls are available for \$100 Thursday through Sunday. There are no options for day stalls at this show. Checks may be written to: Leone Equestrians, or LEI, and mailed to Anne Polli, PO Box 681, Wilton, CA 95693 or you may hold your stall by entering credit card information on your entry blank. If you are simply riding in classes on Friday and Saturday, pre-entry is not necessary.
- 2.** Remember, you must be a member of SAHJA to ride in the Finals. You can join online at sahja.org, or we will have membership forms at the show.
- 3.** If you are uncertain about your qualification status, or believe the point tabulation doesn't agree with yours, please let SAHJA know before the show. Go to sahja.org, click on "Standings" at the top of the page, then select "Medal" from the drop down menu. If you have questions, email: sahjapoints@outlook.com for assistance/clarification.
- 4.** If you are a Medal finalist, you will receive one Sunday lunch for each of your medal final class entries. There is a place on the entry blank to order additional lunches for trainers, parents, family members and friends. We order based on reservations so make sure you write in a number for additional lunches when you send your entry.

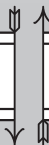

The SAHJA Medal Finals

SPECIFICATIONS

The Medal Finals will be conducted under a multiple judge system with open scoring. Finalists will be judged over two complete courses, and at least the top four riders will return to perform additional work. The SAHJA Pony Medal shall be judged over a course of fences 2'3" in height. The SAHJA Mini Medal shall be judged over a course of fences 2'6" in height. The SAHJA Child/Adult Medal shall be judged over a course of fences 3' in height. Riders competing in the Finals must be members of SAHJA.

In the Mini Medal Finals and the Pony Medal Finals, at least the top fifteen (15) riders after the first round must come back for the second round. Management may elect to have more than fifteen (15) riders return for the second round, however, these specifications must be clearly stated in the prize list.

Scoring will be open numeric scoring, with scores announced after each round. First round scores from each judge will be averaged for a single score, second round scores will also be averaged for a single score. These two scores will be added together and averaged for one score to be carried into the work-off. Any work-off will be given its own score by each judge and this score shall be added to the subtotal and averaged again for the final score. Work-off scores will not be announced. Highest total score is the winner. Ribbons are presented through 10th.

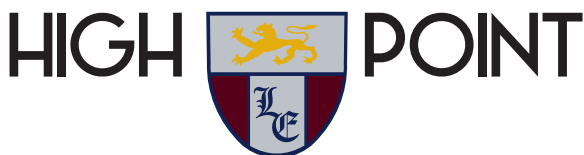

RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS

RULES: US Equestrian Federation and SAHJA guidelines will be followed. The decision of the management and judges are final.

MEDAL FINALS: For rules and specifications for the SAHJA Medal Finals, please refer to the Medal Finals page in this prize list

ENTRY FEES: All regular classes are \$20.00. Leadline is \$10.00. Stake classes are \$35 with a \$5 add back. Medal Finals classes are \$65.00. Stalls are available with pre-payment for \$100 for the show. Thursday and Friday schooling available at \$25.00/horse if you are entered in the show, \$35 if you are not showing. **You must pick up a schooling number in the office before entering the rings.**

BILLING: There will be a \$25 charge on all returned checks. No numbers will be issued without an open check on file in the office. A \$25 charge will be assessed to any accounts that must be billed after the show's conclusion.

AWARDS: Prizes to first, ribbons to sixth.

ATTIRE: Boots, collared shirts, approved helmets and britches are required.

DOGS: All dogs must be leashed and the leash must be in control of a responsible human handler. Those in non-compliance may be fined an additional \$25 which will be added to the owner's bill, fine is at management's discretion.

CLASS SIZE: classes with 4 entries or less may be combined or canceled. If entries warrant, large classes will be split.

ROOKIE RIDER CLASS: open to riders in their first year of showing.

MINI STIRRUP: open to junior or amateur riders who have never shown over fences 2' or higher.

SHORT STIRRUP: open to riders 11 and under that are not competing in any class at this show with fences 3'0" or higher or have never shown in previous years over fences 3'0" or higher.

LONG STIRRUP: open to riders 12 & over that have never shown over fences 3'0" or higher.

PONY HUNTERS: open to ponies 14.2 hands and under ridden by a junior.

SAHJA QUALIFYING MEDAL CLASSES: Riders need not be SAHJA members. Points are awarded based on number starting the class. Five points qualifies for the Finals.

ALMADEN FARMS/CHRISTENSEN'S JR/AM MEDAL: Open to Junior and Amateur riders. This class may be held over hunter or jumper type fences, 2'9" in height. Three riders must enter for the class to count. Any rider showing in classes with fences over 3'3" in height at this show may not show in the medal. The course must include a combination, two changes of direction and two tests built into the course, i.e. halt, back, etc. Additional testing is at the judge's discretion.

CLOVERLEAF EQUITATION CLASS: Open to Jr. and Amateur riders not showing in any classes over 3'6" in height. To be judged over a jumper course of not less than 9 fences at 3' in height. To be judged on hands, seat, guidance and control of the horse on a jumper-type of ride. There will NOT be a time allowed and a tone WILL be used to signal the rider to begin the course. Any jumper type bit or equipment is allowed. Jumping penalties will be considered in accordance with USEF Equitation rules. Additional work-offs, after the initial round will be at the judge's discretion and any number of riders may be asked for additional work. At least three riders must complete the course for the class to count. First and second place in the class qualify for the finals.
